

World Driving Championship Racetracks

Bergen Racetrack - Thursday 14th of May

Bergen Racetrack is situated in a beautiful suburb about 15 km outside Bergen City on the west coast of Norway. The track was opened 15th of June 1985.



Biri Racetrack - Friday 15th of May

Biri is situated upon Mjøsa, the biggest lake in Norway. The area around is an important factor in Norwegian breeding, especially the cold blood horse.



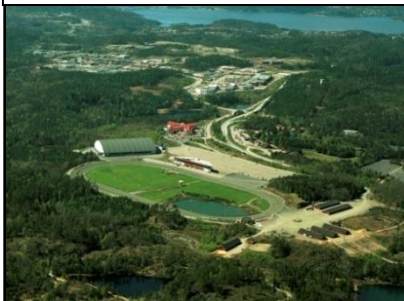
Jarlsberg Racetrack - Saturday 16th of May

Jarlsberg has arranged races since 1935. It is situated just outside Tønsberg, a charming coast city southwest of Oslo.



Sørlandet Racetrack - Monday 18th of May

Norway's newest racetrack was opened 16th of July 1988 with Sugarcane Hanover as a noble guest. This modern track is built in the very south of Norway.



Bjerke Racetrack - Wednesday 20th of May

Norway's main and biggest track was built 24th of June 1928. It was the first track to offer totalisator betting in Norway, and is owned by the Norwegian Trotting Association. The biggest event is Oslo Grand Prix in May every year.
